Additional 125 General Admission Tickets Released for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday Rounds of the Butterfield Bermuda Championship

SOUTHAMPTON, BERMUDA (October 20, 2021) – The Butterfield Bermuda Championship announced today the addition of 125 general admission tickets per day for Friday, October 29, Saturday, October 30, and Sunday, October 31. The previously sold-out rounds will now welcome additional spectators as the Championship has been granted an exemption extension by the Minister of Youth, Culture and Sport for the PGA TOUR event returning October 28 to 31 to Port Royal Golf Course in Southampton.

The additional general admission tickets are available starting today on a first-come, first-serve basis, and fans are encouraged to act quickly to purchase tickets. Tickets will not be sold at the gate and are available only in advance through the Championship website. No tickets remain for Thursday, October 28. All spectators two years and older must have a ticket to access the grounds of Port Royal Golf Course.

Overlooking Port Royal Golf Course's signature 16th hole, hospitality tickets include all-inclusive beverage and light hors d'oeuvres. Less than 30 tickets remain per day, Thursday to Sunday.
