"We have worked with local authorities to ensure the safe reopening of the Digicel Business Ocean Club," said Executive Director, Sean Sovacool. "The structure on hole 16 has been reviewed by professional engineers to allow for ticket holders to return to this picturesque location and enjoy world-class golf. An additional update will be provided for Saturday and Sunday patrons."

It is the responsibility of spectators to ensure they have a valid SafeKey downloaded or printed before arrival.
