



2021 Butterfield Bermuda Championship | Travel Requirements

Thank you for your interest in covering the Butterfield Bermuda Championship. The event will be conducted under the guidance of leading medical experts, in a manner that complies with guidelines set by the Bermuda Government.

Before planning travel to Bermuda, take a moment to learn about our entry requirements, on-island health and safety measures, testing capacity and more. Questions may be directed to Becky Kolberg at becky@butterfieldbdachampionship.com.

Travelers to Bermuda must be vaccinated* or will be required to complete a mandatory 14 day quarantine at their accommodation.

* An immunized traveler is someone who has received the full course of a vaccine manufactured by:

- Pfizer BioNTECH,
- AstraZeneca,
- Serum Institute of India,
- Jansen/Johnson & Johnson,
- Moderna
- Sinopharm/BIBP
- Sinovac

Please review the items below for travel to Bermuda. Each step must be followed before boarding a flight to Bermuda.

1. **PRE-TRAVEL COVID-19 PCR TEST:** a **COVID-19 PCR** test is required and must be taken no more than four (4) days before arrival in Bermuda. Requirements for a valid PCR test are available here: <https://www.gov.bm/coronavirus-pre-vetted-travel-authorisation>
2. **AUTHORIZATION FORM:** each traveler must complete and upload their negative COVID-19 PCR test result **AND** Vaccination record to the **Bermuda Travel Authorization Form 1 to 3 days** before departure to Bermuda. A \$75 fee is required, which includes the cost of a COVID-19 PCR on-site test in Bermuda.

 - b. **All travelers must upload negative PCR test results and Vaccination record to this site before travel**
3. **ARRIVAL TEST:** Visitors will **undergo COVID-19 PCR testing upon arrival** at the L.F. Wade International Airport administered by the Bermuda government. Testing is also required on day 4 and day 10 on the island.



- a. **SAFEKEY:** A QR code will be automatically generated for each traveler once negative test result from the airport, or any other test while on-island is confirmed. The QR codes contain information necessary to verify the results of negative tests or vaccination. Several local businesses ask for this QR code for access.
 - i. The initial QR code is valid until the next test is required (day 4). Another QR code will be generated after day 4 test, which will be valid until the day 10 test

4. **HOUSING QUARANTINE:** All inbound travelers to Bermuda are required to quarantine at their hotel or resort until a negative test result is returned. Results from the airport test administered by the government typically takes between 8-12 hours.

- For media staying at the Hamilton Princess, round-trip shuttle service will be provided between the Hamilton Princess and Port Royal Golf Course. The shuttle will leave at the top of the hour from the Hamilton Princess and the bottom of the hour from Port Royal Golf Course.
- Please note, cars are not available to rent in Bermuda which is why we encourage all non-local media to stay at the host hotel.
