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**Q. The difference between yesterday and today, it seemed like you could be a little bit more aggressive today?**

**PATRICK REED:** Played A lot harder for me today. I mean, today was gettable. I felt like the pins were a little bit more tucked in a little bit kind of more subtle areas today compared to yesterday, but there wasn't that much wind out there. It was very gettable. As long as you're playing the ball in the fairway, hitting some quality iron shots, you could shoot a low number out there. Unfortunately, I didn't capitalize where I needed to and really just a couple tee shots here or there that put me in bad spots where I had to scramble rather than being able to attack and make birdies.

**Q. Towards the end of last season you struggled, then you got pneumonia going into the TOUR Championship. How do you feel now and do you feel like you're close to game shape?**

**PATRICK REED:** I feel great. I feel like I'm already in game shape, just need to get the game going. I feel like I'm doing a lot of things really, really well, just not quite getting much out of it, and the loose golf shot ends up coming at the wrong time. Yesterday a loose one there on -- I birdied the first three, loose one there on 4 with a 4-iron out of bounds, have to reload and today had a loose one -- well, back-to-back loose ones on 15 with driver, went left, lost ball, then went right in the hazard, got up and down on that to make double. So it's stuff like that that is just really just killing the rounds and hard to get kind of momentum. Once we can tidy those up, I feel like we'll be hitting the ground running, but really I just need to take that one shot out of there.
