Q. Did you kind of have an idea that you might have been on the right side of this wave after what happened yesterday?

I think, I think when it's that windy, you do have an advantage going second off because you see how the course is playing. You go from maybe a mindset of trying to shoot 4, 5 under to basically, hey, even par's a good score. That kind of helps. You don't really know that in the morning as much. Yeah, I think the scores are going to be pretty low this afternoon.

Q. How important was the start that you got off to today?

PETER UIHLEIN: Yeah, it was good. Yeah, it was still pretty windy this morning, so getting off to a quick start, getting under par early was nice. Yeah, anytime you start with a bunch of birdies and kind of right the ship a little bit, it makes the day a little bit easier.

Q. You're in the top five this week in scrambling. Do any of them stand out to you today maybe?

PETER UIHLEIN: No, yesterday was -- I chipped unbelievable yesterday. I chipped really well, putted very well and you kind of have to do that on a day like yesterday because it's so hard, you're not hitting a lot of greens, but I was able to get up and down. Believe it or not, it was stress-free, too. It wasn't like I was holing 10-footers for par, they were pretty much tap-ins, so it was a pretty nice day yesterday.
