JUSTIN LOWER: Steady, patient. If I could have gotten some putts to fall, it could have been really good. Caught a lot of edges, but happy with it, good round.

Q. What's your mentality heading into tomorrow? You're going to be maybe five, six shots back. How do you kind of attack the course knowing you guys are going to get some bad weather?

Q. Is it sometimes an advantage to possibly be chasing when you get some bad weather?

JUSTIN LOWER: I think so, for sure. I think chasing more than -- I don't want to say guys protect, but I know like I'm guilty of it, I've protected when I've had a lead. I think chasing, you can definitely be more aggressive.

And I've played with less to lose I guess. Yeah, I'm looking forward to tomorrow. Never been in this position, but I'm really looking forward to it.
