Q. Kind of describe how the round went today.

PATRICK RODGERS: Yeah, I mean, obviously the 11th hole, having four chips on one hole doesn't help your round, but I didn't feel like it took the wind out of my sails. I just didn't make anything the next few holes. The three-putt was frustrating there on 17, but really nice to close with a birdie. I think with the conditions tomorrow, anything can happen. Obviously I'd like to be in a better position, especially after the start, but yeah, still just going to keep plugging away.

Q. You have more experience than a lot of guys on this leaderboard as far as you've been in this position before, you've been in and around the lead heading into Sunday. What can you take kind of mentally with that going into tomorrow, especially knowing the conditions could get a little dicey?

PATRICK RODGERS: Yeah, honestly, golf doesn't feel super hard after what I went through this summer. I was playing my last round of the Korn Ferry Finals, came down to the last few holes. I don't feel like there's anything I can experience on Tour that's going to be more difficult than that.

I'm just going to kind of lean on that experience most recently. Yeah, it's a position I've been in before. I feel like I have the game to close the door. Just got to keep putting myself in position so things go my way.
