Q. Assess your round out there today.

VINCENT WHALEY: I think I got a lot out of it. I didn't hit it very good the whole day, especially off the tee, but I made the most of it, I'd say.

Q. How are you feeling playing in the final group, PGA TOUR, third round here in Bermuda? How were you feeling as you started out?

VINCENT WHALEY: Yeah, it was cool honestly just being here. I'm pretty good buddies with Taylor now at this point. It was fun playing with him and cool watching both these guys hit the ball 340, so yeah, it was fun.

Q. Some bad weather coming in tomorrow, tee times have been moved up. How do you kind of -- what's your mentality heading into tomorrow chasing Taylor by five shots back? What's the mentality knowing the weather's going to be a little dicey?

VINCENT WHALEY: I'm just doing my thing out there, just trying to plod along. I don't know, you don't know what the weather's going to be, you don't know what these guys are going to shoot, so it's just do your thing and try to do as good as you can.

Q. Growing up, was winning on the PGA TOUR I guess somewhere high on your list?

VINCENT WHALEY: Yeah.

Q. How does it feel now? I know you're not there, but you're close.

VINCENT WHALEY: Yeah, definitely getting closer. It's the dream, right? What you wanted ever since you were a kid. It would be amazing, but I've got a long way to go before that's reality.
