SCOTT STALLINGS (-12)



Q. Scott, apparently you didn't get the memo that there weren't scoring conditions today. Tell me how you shot 62.

SCOTT STALLINGS: I had a good attitude. I felt fortunate to be there. I got off to a horrible start in the tournament and I was basically 6 over through seven. Had a rough hole on 15 and just kept telling my caddie, I just want an opportunity to kind of -- I felt the golf course had kind of beat me down and I wanted to kind of stand up and punch back a little bit, and whatever mentality that brought out in me, I need to figure out a way to tap into that a little bit more. Today was just kind of try to have the best attitude you possibly can and go out there and try to hit it as solid as you can because anything can happen. The range of emotions and weather conditions that we dealt with in the last, however long that was, was kind of all over the place. You were hitting good shots that ended up in bad places and bad shots ended up in good places, that's just kind of the way the day was. Keep moving forward. Obviously to shoot what I did was a huge bonus, but was happy with the way I kind of competed all week.

Q. It's not your lowest on the PGA TOUR, but is it your best round on the PGA TOUR? You had 60 I know at the Barracuda some years ago. What do you think?

SCOTT STALLINGS: Yeah, definitely, just kind of the way that we've dealt with everything. And my caddie kept keeping me positive and keeping me dry, and I really don't like rain gear, so he likes to laugh, he said the moment I pulled the" (inaudible,) he said, "I knew was raining." So felt like to be where I am sitting here talking to you guys Sunday afternoon after I had literally packed all my stuff out of my locker Friday afternoon sent me into a good week and look forward to building on the next few events.

Q. Are you going to stick around to see what happens here with the conditions?

SCOTT STALLINGS: No, sir. I think these guys are too good. I think they go and if the shots are executed right coming down the stretch, they're going to have short shots. I think you're going to see some birdies at 17, with the pin up on 16, tee up, pin's on the front right on 15, kind of get through 14 and the last few holes, well executed. Pin on 18's a birdie pin. I think there's going to be some good shots coming down the stretch.
