Today – Areas of moderate rain to start the day with some lighter pockets or gaps in the precipitation over the next 1-2 hours. Expect an area of widespread moderate rain will envelop Bermuda around 8-9am with this activity set to linger into the early afternoon. The remainder of the afternoon is likely to see scattered areas of rain redevelop – with some heavy downpours remaining possible. Additionally, there is a 10-20% risk for embedded thunderstorms. South-southeasterly winds may occasionally gust up to 20 mph in showers.

Forecast rainfall through 7pm: Around 0.50", locally higher possible in heavy cells or any thunderstorms.

Extended forecast – Rounds of unsettled weather will continue through early next week as an area of low pressure lifts up from the south-southwest and stalls to the west of Bermuda. This low pressure area is expected to draw in very high moisture values – leading to periods of rain that will be heavy at times. Additionally, there will be enough instability present to promote an isolated to widely scattered thunderstorm risk each day. Forecast guidance continues to signal a more widespread, heavier rain/embedded thunderstorm potential tonight into Friday morning. Winds may gust between 30-35 mph for portions of Friday.
