
Q. Kevin, how would you characterize the round out there today?

KEVIN YU: It's good. I mean, it's playing really tough today, really windy and wind just sometimes really not consistent. So yeah, I played really solid today, just tried to hit as many fairways as I can and trying to hit as many greens as I can. Even I missed a few greens and still be able to make up and down, so it was a good day today.

Q. What do you feel like you did best out there today?

KEVIN YU: Just kind of, you know, be able to hit all fairways. I think that's really a big key out here for today because the wind is such a big factor on this course today and just hit all fairways and hit all greens and give myself a lot of chances to make some birdies.

Q. This is your fourth start in your rookie season. What have you learned so far about yourself playing on the PGA TOUR that may help you out tomorrow?

KEVIN YU: Just really have to just trust your game, just be really patient about every circumstance because, you know, like you might face different weather or whatever tomorrow, so just trying to be very consistent and trust my game and just be 100 percent on every shot, yeah.

Q. The finish looks wild on the scorecard, a couple of bogeys and a couple of birdies to finish. How does that make you feel at the end of the day?

KEVIN YU: Definitely have had good momentum going to the final round tomorrow. Finish with two birdies, which helps a lot for the leaderboard. Two bogeys, I think it's still not like I hit a really bad shot, just 15 the wind was a little weird there so I hit it in the bunker, have to kind of lay up and then made bogey there. On 16, just the wind was just wild, just have to kind of hit it in front of the ocean back to the green and hit like past it like 40 feet and hit it a little short and three-putted. Other than that, it's just a solid day and played really solid today.

Q. How much did playing at Arizona State and playing in like major divisional college golf kind of prepare you for professional golf as you've had a lot of success early on in your career?

KEVIN YU: Yeah, just for Arizona State, we have very good practice facilities in Arizona. So, I mean, we have basically all the shots you want to hit out here, like driver, you can find everything out there. So just for the practice help me a lot throughout the last five years.

And then we always play against all the best players in the world, college players in the world. So, I mean, kind of get to prepare to like Korn Ferry or even PGA TOUR I think just really helped me a lot throughout my career.

Also, like time management, got to kind of manage your school work and play golf, what time you get up, what time you're going to go practice. I think all those processes just helped me a lot like throughout my career and kind of got me here today, yeah.

Q. Did I see a picture of you back there recently carrying your own staff bag?

KEVIN YU: Yeah, yeah. I wanted to play with the team and I went to like kind of do all the recovery in the morning and I forgot to switch the stand bag. I feel bad just using a cart and all the guys are just carrying their own bags, so I just take out all the unnecessary stuff in my bag and just try and play with the team. I don't want to feel bad. But yeah, I carried my staff bag for 18 holes. I was really tired, so I'm really thankful for my caddie.
