Tickets for the 2022 Butterfield Bermuda Championship will go on sale Monday, Sept 12 at 9am

SOUTHAMPTON, BERMUDA (September 9, 2022) Tickets to the 2022 Butterfield Bermuda Championship will go on sale Monday, September 12th via the official tournament website. The public is encouraged to act quickly, as access to upgraded tickets will sell out.

Danielle Baiunco, Tournament Director, says, "This year, the tournament will open its gates to welcome a crowd with an unrestricted capacity of spectators for the first time since its debut on the PGA TOUR calendar in 2019. We are truly ecstatic to provide the local community and visitors to the island with an enhanced experience inclusive of a junior ticket policy, post-play live entertainment, a family zone and more. We will announce our full schedule of events during a press conference on Monday morning."

Daily general admission tickets for Thursday, October 27 to Sunday, October 30 will be available online for \$35 per day. Individuals may choose to upgrade their access to the Digicel Business Ocean Club; these tickets are \$250 per person per day and include food, beverages, and other perks. Tickets will not be available at the gate and should be bought before the event. Youth 15 and under are admitted free to the tournament with a ticketed adult. This does not apply to hospitality spaces, and all spectators over the age of 2 entering hospitality venues must hold a pre-purchased ticket.

The Butterfield Bermuda Championship will follow the PGA TOUR fan safety guide, which still suggests maintaining a social distance in highly populated areas. Mask-wearing is advised but not mandatory in crowds, and per local Bermuda guidelines, masks are suggested when indoors. If you are feeling unwell, we kindly advise you to stay home.

There are still volunteer opportunities available. Go behind the scenes as a Gallery Management Ambassador or see the action as a Walking Scorer. Volunteers can donate their time and earn a local non-profit of their choice a donation of \$200 by volunteering for a minimum of three shifts throughout the tournament. Scheduled for **October 27 to 30** at **Port Royal Golf Course** in Southampton, the 2022 Butterfield Bermuda Championship will feature a field of 132 players, 72 holes of stroke play and a purse of US **\$6.5 million prize money**. The tournament's charitable impact in Bermuda currently exceeds **\$1.1 million to local non-profits**, with plans to significantly grow its impact on the community in years to come. This official FedEx Cup event will showcase Bermuda to its worldwide spectators.
