
Q. What did you do well today?

RYO HISATSUNE: Yeah, especially today windy day so find the fairway and then hitting shots really well. So yeah, I'm happy to making 4 under.

Q. Are you comfortable playing in windy conditions?

RYO HISATSUNE: Especially like I like some more control the ball so especially today is a really control to find the ball so get a little lucky.

Q. You've played well here before, some good rounds the previous year. What do you like about the golf course?

RYO HISATSUNE: Last year the experience windy so more keep it (indiscernible.) So yeah, good help in the last year in my experience, yeah. It's three more rounds, yeah.

Q. Given your position in the FedExCup Fall, how important is this week and next week for you?

RYO HISATSUNE: Yeah, unfortunately like 92, something like that, close to the standings, yeah. A bit nervous, yeah. Actually a little nervous but more just playing the golf so like going to keeping golf, so yeah.

Q. Do you feel like you handle the nerves pretty well?

RYO HISATSUNE: Yeah, a little bit, but it's OK. I just, yeah, have to surviving on Tour so I do my best.

Q. On 18 there, I know your tee shot kind of went a little bit far right. What did you have to do to kind of settle back in and get in for a par?

RYO HISATSUNE: Actually I didn't hit it -- it was really good hit but ball was -- I didn't saw that, so end like 50-yard far right so actually was surprised. But was really good angle, then 85 yards. But it's narrow green and this angle it's just very scary, but I just get lucky, then getting the slope and then close to the birdie, but like 10 feet like making birdie putt but miss it. Yeah, it's very lucky.

Q. Very first player off this morning. Do you enjoy being in that spot, kind of the first player hitting the first tee shot?



RYO HISATSUNE: Yeah, yeah. Starting windy, 7:00 a.m. still windy. Yeah, very enjoyable, yeah. Especially on Tuesday in the practice round like more windy, so like yeah.

Q. When you're off at 7:00 and first, what time do you get up to start your preparation?

RYO HISATSUNE: About I think 5:50, something like that, hour, 10 minutes before, but it's still windy and cold.

Q. What would you say is the best part of your game?

RYO HISATSUNE: I just like ball-striking, find the fairway, some like iron shots, yeah. To be honest, like I horrible putting in this year, so going to make a bit of help some wind.

Q. Aside from the horrible putting this year, have you enjoyed the experience this year playing on the PGA TOUR?

RYO HISATSUNE: Yeah, yeah, yeah, getting well, especially I had four top-10 this year, like a really good season, but like unfortunately in like middle season just didn't get like a top-10 or like close to winning. But yeah, I keeping head up and hang out, like I want to win, so like yeah, more stay grind, yeah.
