MAX McGREEVY: Yeah, I would say a round like this has happened multiple times on Tour this year where I kind of get going, I just want to go off and shoot 8 or 9 under par and kind of have some mishap, different things that I could have done differently, maybe could have played better. I haven't quite finished it off like I did today like I have the rest of the year. So happy to kind of fight that back and get a couple coming in because it was a great round of golf, would hate to kind of throw away some shots like that. Yeah, excited for the weekend.
