VINCE WHALEY (-10)

Q. Vince, you've been coming here a long time, played several events here, had a great record here. Was that one of the most difficult days that you can remember in all the times here?

VINCE WHALEY: Yeah, I think so. It's always windy here, you get some pretty brutal rounds, but that back nine was really hard today.

Q. You got to 13 in sort of the middle of the front nine, obviously got off to a good start, just like you said, a struggle on the back nine. What did you feel about that when you made the turn?

VINCE WHALEY: Yeah, I knew going into today that that front nine is a little more guarded through the first seven holes so you kind of had to make some birdies and hold on, and I did a good job of that and I didn't do as good of a job holding on as I wanted. Yeah, you had to get 'em early because it's just tough to hit anything close on that back nine.

Q. You finished and you're in, there's still a lot of golf to be played, Adam and some others. There's still a chance. What do you feel, what do you think might happen?

VINCE WHALEY: Yeah, there's always a chance, especially at that closing holes, but I'm pretty disappointed right now. I'm really upset with how I played on 17 and that tee shot I hit. Yeah, not too happy.

Q. Why do you think you play so well here?

VINCE WHALEY: I love the wind. I grew up in Texas and I feel like I'm used to the wind. I feel like all of us play a little better when we get out of our own heads and can just kind of see shot, hit shot. That's what you have to do out here. There's no perfect swing.
