<u> 2025</u>

- The first round was suspended due to darkness at 5:27 p.m. with 15 players yet to complete the round. It resumed at 7:26 a.m. Friday morning. The second round started as scheduled.
- The second round was suspended due to darkness at 5:27 p.m. with 6 players yet to complete the round. It resumed at 7:20 a.m. Saturday morning. The third round started at 8:20 a.m.
- The third round saw play briefly suspended at 11:22 a.m. for a non-dangerous rain event as a squall passed through while players were held in place. The delay lasted one minute.
- Matthew Riedel tied the tournament record for low back nine score with a 29. He is the seventh player to hit that mark. The most recent was Wesley Bryan in the 3rd round in 2024. During the third round, Riedel posted two eagles and birdies on the backside.

2024

- Rafael Campos claimed his first career PGA TOUR win six days after the birth of his first daughter.
- Wesley Bryan tied the 18-hole Butterfield Bermuda Championship and Port Royal Golf Course record with a third round -10, 61. He tied Taylor Pendrith's record set in the second round in 2021 and matched by Alex Noren in the first round of 2023. Starting on #10, Bryan tied the tournament record for low back nine score with a 29, including four birdies and an eagle.
- Andrew Novak started on #1 and shot 29 to tie the record for lowest front nine. He posted seven birdies, including four in a row.
- Camiko Smith tied the lowest round by a Bermudian with an opening -2, 69. Jarryd Dillas is the only other local to break 70 in the event, shooting 69 in the first round in 2022.
- Nick Hardy posted the first albatross in tournament history during the second round. He carded a 2 on the par-5 #17 hole.





- The first round was suspended due to darkness at 5:19 p.m. with 21 players yet to complete the round. It resumed at 7:00 a.m. Friday morning. The second round started as scheduled.
- The second round was suspended due to darkness at 5:20 p.m. with 11 players on the course. It resumed at 6:57 a.m. Saturday morning.

2023

- Alex Noren tied the 18-hole Butterfield Bermuda Championship and Port Royal Golf Course record with an opening round 10-under, 61. He tied **Taylor Pendrith's** record set in the second round in 2021. He also set a new tournament record for most birdies in a round with eleven birdies in the first round.
- Noren set a new tournament record for low 36-hole score with -15, 61-66=127. The broke the previous record of -14 set in 2022 by **Ben** Crane.
- Oliver Betschart (15 years, 3 months, 8 days) became the youngest participant ever in the tournament. Kenny Leseur (15 years, 9 months, 22 days) previously competed in 2019.
- The first round was suspended due to darkness at 5:31 p.m. with 15 players yet to complete the round. It resumed at 7:45 a.m. Friday morning. The second round started as scheduled.

2022

- Austin Smotherman and Harrison Endycott tied the tournament record for low opening round with a 9-under, 62.
- Ben Crane set the tournament record for low 36-hole score with a -14, 66-62=128.
- **Denny McCarthy** tied the tournament record for lowest back-nine score with a 29 in the first round. **Ben Crane** then tied the lowest back-nine score with a 29 in the second round.
- **Smotherman**, who played in Bermuda last year for the first time, saw his opening round score improve by 14 strokes from 2021. He posted a 76 last year and a 62 this year.
- Jarryd Dillas became the first Bermudian to break 70 in the tournament with an opening round 69.
- Kevin Yu set a new tournament record for eagles in a single round, carding 3 on Thursday. He eagled #2, #7 and #17.
- The second round was suspended due to darkness at 7:01 p.m. with two players, **Tano Goya** and **Jarryd Dillas**, yet to complete the round. It resumed at 9:12 a.m. and was completed at 9:17 a.m.

2021

- At 10-under 61, Taylor Pendrith set 18-hole Butterfield Bermuda Championship and Port Royal Golf Course record.
- With 2nd and 3rd Rd scores of 61-65, Pendrith set a new tournament record for lowest back-to-back rounds score with 126. The previous record was 129 by **Brendon Todd** in 2019.
- Camiko Smith tied the tournament record for low nine-hole score with a 29 on the back.
- Defending champion Brian Gay makes the cut on the number with scores of 75-67.
- Callum Tarren was disqualified due to signing incorrect scorecard after the second round.
- The first round was suspended for five minutes from 12:38 to 12:43 p.m. due to high winds and a rainstorm.
- The first round was suspended at 6:34 p.m. due to darkness. 13 players had not completed their rounds. It resumed at 8:15 a.m. Friday and was completed at 9:12 a.m. The second round began as scheduled at 7:35 a.m.
- The three hardest holes were on the back nine, with #16 (1st), #15 (2nd) and #13 (3rd).
- Four of the five easiest holes were on the front nine, with #7 (17th), #5 (16th), #2 (15th) and #6 (14th). #18 was the 17th hole.

2020

- The second round was suspended by darkness with five players on the course. Resumed Saturday morning.
- Fred Funk joined Sam Snead, Jack Nicklaus and Tom Watson as only players 64 and older to make the cut in a PGA TOUR event since 1970.
- Brian Gay won on the first playoff hole with a birdie on #18.
- Wyndham Clark recorded eagles on #2 in each of the first two rounds.
- **Denny McCarthy** posted a final round 63, with birdies on six straight holes (Nos. 2-7).
- Four of the five hardest holes were on the back nine, with #16 (1st), #15 (2nd), #13 (3rd) and #14 (5th). #8 was 2nd.
- Four of the five easiest holes were on the front nine, with #7 (18th), #2 (16th), #5 (15th) and #6 (14th). #17 was 17th.

2019

- Rob Oppenheim had seven birdies in eight holes in the first round on Holes 1-8 (par on #4)
- **Brendon Todd** started the final round with nine birdies in his first eleven holes. He went par, birdie, bir
- Four of the five hardest holes were on the back nine, with #11 (1st), #16 (2nd), #13 (3rd) and #14 (5th). #1 was 4th.
- Four of the five easiest holes were on the front nine, with #7 (18th), #2 (17th), #3 (15th) and #6 (14th). #17 was 16th.
